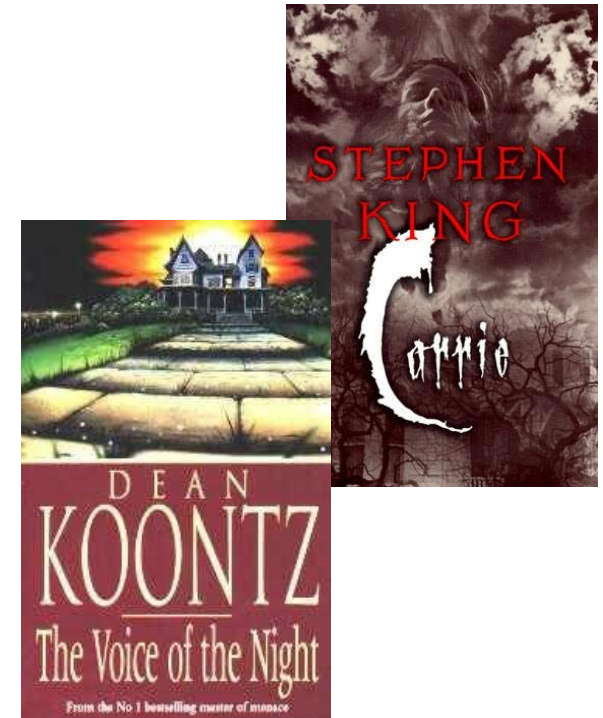
Amy girl Wood, Bari
